Holiday Service

On Monday, February 20th, 2023 (President's Day), all lines will operate on a weekend schedule.

On Monday, January 16th, 2023 (Martin Luther King Jr. Day) and on Monday, April 17th, 2023 (Patriot's Day), all lines will operate on a regular weekday schedule.

Times in purple with "f" indicate a flag stop: Passengers must tell the conductor that they wish to leave. Passengers waiting to board must be visible on the platform for the train to stop.

Times in blue with "L" indicate an early departure: The train may leave ahead of schedule at these stops.

Bikes: Bicycles are allowed on trains with the bicycle symbol shown below the train number.

High level platform and bridge plate available. Visit mbta.com/accessibility for more information.

VIA FAIRMOUNT LINE: Operates via the Fairmount Line between Readville and South Station. See the Fairmount Line schedule for all stops.

For additional service to Readville Station, refer to the Fairmount Line schedule for particular trains.

For additional service to Hyde Park, Forest Hills, Ruggles or Back Bay stations, refer to the dedicated Hyde Park – Back Bay – South Station schedule.

Schedules may change in the event of severe weather

During weather events, these symbols will communicate service level and impact on passengers. Service level for the following day will be announced mid afternoon on the prior day.
