-On Sundays, July 28, Train 2200 (5:35 am from Bradford) & Train 2201 (7:00 am from North Station) will operate as intended and make all stops between Bradford & North Station.

-Regular train service will resume after 7 pm on both days of both weekends.

-There will be no service at North Wilmington Station. Passengers may consider boarding Lowell Line trains at Wilmington station.
