# Wollaston Station Improvements Construction Status – On Schedule

## Current Activities:

- Site Improvements Around Station.
- Finish Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing (MEP) Continues
- Three Elevators Being Completed
- Two Escalators Being Completed
- Newport Avenue Entrance Construction Continues
- Interior Finishes Being Installed
- Fire Alarm and Fire Protection Systems Being Installed.
- Automated Fare Collection Equipment Being Installed.






# Quincy Center Garage Demolition and Improvements –Substantially Complete

- Elevator Re-Opened on January 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Burgin Pkwy. Accessible Walkway Open
- Waterproofing of Existing Concrete Deck Complete
- Busway Restored to Original Location.
- Minor Punch-List Items Being Addressed

## Current Activities:


- Quincy Adams garage repairs have begun, and will continue to be completed in phases.

# MBTA Quincy Stations - Parking


- 613 Spaces Available at North Quincy
- Hancock Street Lot Typically Fills up by 7:30AM
- Newport Ave. Lot Typically fills up by 8:00AM
- 425 Spaces Available at Wollaston with Free Bus Shuttle Service between North Quincy and, Quincy Center Station, until Wollaston Station Reopens
- 2,000 Spaces Available at Quincy Adams
- Additional Options to Park at:
  - Braintree Station Surface Lots
  - Mattapan Station Surface Lot





# Wollaston Bus Shuttle until Station Opens

- 4 buses operate off-peak
- 7 buses operate at peak more frequently – now every 5-7 minutes vs. every 10 minutes previously
- 1500 boardings per rush hour on average

- Transports to North Quincy or Quincy Center Stations
