

## Quick Tips:

### If you have a CharlieTicket:

- Make it a practice to recharge your CharlieTicket.
- To keep it working properly, please don't punch holes in it. Have it ready to insert into the farebox.

### If you need a bus transfer:

- Ask your operator for a transfer when boarding the bus.

### Ways to shorten your boarding time:

- Consider purchasing several rides at one time on a CharlieTicket. Simply pay at the bus farebox with a \$1, \$5, \$10 or \$20 bill and you'll receive remaining balance in a stored value CharlieTicket, good for quick and easy use anywhere Charlie is accepted.
- Save even more time by buying your CharlieTicket before boarding the bus. Purchase at a T station fare vending machine or a local retail sales terminal. See [mbta.com](http://mbta.com) for locations.
- Purchase a pass. We recommend purchasing a CharlieTicket pass – it's a savings over paying cash every day and gives you instant access on all applicable MBTA services.
